

## CAMP ALLEGHENY BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

**Please review these agreements with you child.  
Both the parent and child must sign this agreement.**

Our goal is that each child, become aware and appreciate God's great outdoors, realize that each person is worthy of God's love and the love of others, grow in their responsibility to themselves, others and the world, learn and grow in their social and communication skills, learn and try new activities and skills, and to have fun! We are blessed to have a beautiful outdoor setting to share with your children. We have walls of trees, a floor of soil, ceiling of clouds and lighting from the sun, moon and stars. Your child is blessed to not be confined in 4 walls. This restricts areas of a child's growth and development. However by being outside those four walls we must demand some serious behavior expectations.

These goals are best accomplished if each child and parent understands that the following behavioral expectations will be followed:

Participation in all activities  
Follow requests made by the staff.  
Cooperate with staff & other campers.  
Fighting and name calling will not be tolerated.  
Stay with my counselor and group at all times, do not wander off  
Treat everyone with respect.  
Care for plants and animals of Camp Allegheny  
Stay away from the Pond and Route 30 unless you are on a supervised activity.

We believe it is important to work with parents in helping their children learn to manage their own behavior.

**Below is a list of articles campers should not bring or have in their possession throughout their stay at Camp. Ownership of these articles will mean early departure from Camp Allegheny.**

**Electronic devices:** Cell Phone, Pager, CD player, Walkman, I-pods, Computer games, Tape recorders, Radios, Televisions, etc.

**Weapons:** Knife, switchblade, ax, hatchet, gun, etc.

**Tobacco:** in any form, including snuff.

**Pets** (and don't take any home either)!

**Alcohol**

**Prescription or Non-prescription drugs,** in any form. (See the Camp Nurse)

**Expensive clothing, jewelry, or watches.**

**Snack foods** (Be sensible, snacks in cabins attract mice and ants.)
